Dear Parents,

Welcome to our final full term of the year. I hope you all had a wonderful time over the Easter break and are looking forward to being back.

Our main focusses for the next two half-terms will be 'Sinking of the Titanic' and 'Queens'. These will both explored through our History lessons. We will be learning what the Titanic was, how it sank and what changed as a result of the immense incident. For Queens, we will explore the reigns of Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria. We will use these significant individuals to study the exploration of Europe and creation of an Empire.

Year 2 children will be completing their SATs this half-term, which will help us in establishing their progress before they move into KS2. Year 1 children will be taking their phonics screening test, which will help us establish if there is any support needed in Year 2.

We are fortunate to have Forest Schools/Outdoor Learning running on a **Wednesday afternoon**. Please be aware this will run regardless of the weather. Waterproofs, wellies and a change of shoes are advised in wet weather and sun hats and sun cream in sunnier weather.

PE lessons will continue to be on a **Thursday afternoon** so please ensure that your child has the correct PE kit for these days. It is advisable to have PE kit in school at all times so that we can be flexible when we need to. A reminder also that long hair should be tied back in school and no jewellery should be worn so please ensure your child is able to remove or secure any jewellery they may be wearing.

Below I have outlined some homework that the children will be bringing home:

Year 1 and 2

Challenge Maths books focussing on multiplication tables.	As each section is complete, the children will be tested on them. Children will move on fully from the book when it is learnt in its entirety.
A set of 10 spellings, related to the phonics or spelling rules we will have covered that week.	Given out on Friday to be tested during weekly test (Friday afternoon).

We will continue to monitor the handling of homework through the smiley grid. Children will win house points for completing homework – to boost their motivation. As always, we encourage to you to read with your children at home.
