Welcome back for the final term of the year! I hope you have had an exciting and relaxing Easter holiday.

In the first half term of the summer term, our topic will be learning about the year 1066. The children will think about the events that led up to the Battle of Hastings, who the main contenders were for the throne and then the impact of William the Conqueror's reign.

In the final half term, we will work on 'Natural Resources' with a Geography focus. Within this learning, we will learn where Oceania is, and find out about Australia. We will think about how we would survive in different places in the world. The children will move on to learning about what we need to survive and where it comes from (e.g. food, minerals, clean water, energy). We will finish by thinking about the question 'Is every country equal?'.

Our homework will continue to be sent out on Fridays, to be tested on the following Friday. I encourage Maths challenge booklets to be completed in and outside of school. When we have a chance in class, the children can be tested by myself or another member of staff.

As well as our exciting topics this term, the children in Year 4 will be taking their Multiplication Check in June. This will test all their tables up to 12x12, on a computer. To support them in being ready for this test, please continue to practise their recall of their multiplication facts.
