What your children will be learning this term

English

In English, this term we will be studying a book called 'The Promise' written by Nicola Davies. The children will be writing a narrative story to show a promise to clean our oceans of plastic and pollution.

In Guided Reading, our class book for the term is 'An Alien in the Jam Factory' written by Chrissie Sains. The children will get fully involved with the story, allowing them to read out loud and perform, using both intonation and expression. Lessons will consist of developing their comprehension skills and being able to write about different characters points of view.

Science

The science topic for this term will be rocks and soils. They will research and discover the three different types of rocks. They will learn how they form using the rock cycle. Children will be able to distinguish between the properties of everyday materials such as wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard.

Maths

The children will have opportunities to learn about place value, addition, subtraction, money, length, multiplication and finally division.

Children will learn how to:

- value different numbers using different methods.
- add and subtract mentally and using formal written methods
- use and count money
- measure and recognise units of length
- learn multiples up to the 12 times tables.
- be able to use methods of multiplication and division

History

In History we will be learning about the Ancient Civilisations. This will include the Ancient Egyptians, The Mayans, Ancient Sumerians and the Shang Dynasty. We will be looking at their greatest achievements.

Music

The children will be encouraged to listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions and actions. They will have opportunities to build confidence amongst their peers through speaking opportunities such as talking about their likes and dislikes. The children will also learn many rhymes and songs and be able to talk about books and stories.

Art/DT

This will be an Art focussed term. Children will be investigating through painting, drawing, making collages and photography. This will be inspired by an artist called Sally Payne.

PE

In PE this term Tuesdays will be delivered by Personal Best Education. Wednesdays to be delivered by Mr Harris focussing on footwork and balance.

PSHE (Scarf)

In PSHE we will be discussing the children's relationships with different kinds of people. We will also look at how to respond appropriately to rules and other groups of people.
