What your children will be learning this term

English

Our first English learning journey is using the book 'Goodnight Stories for Rebel Girls' to introduce children to biographies. We will then write our own biography based on somebody who inspired us.

Our other learning journey of the term will be using the text 'Odyssey' by Gillian Cross to learn the story of Homer and write our own version.

Science

In this unit, children will explore the concept of geological time and the importance of fossils to help determine what life existed thousands of years ago.

We will study Mary Anning and her importance to modern day palaeontology.

Maths

Autumn 1 will begin with children developing their understanding of increasingly large numbers (up to millions) through comparing and ordering. Throughout the term, we will consolidate our use of the four operations and use these to solve problems in different contexts.

Geography

We will begin by identifying coastlines around the United Kingdom and comparing their similarities and differences.

We will then begin to explore why coastlines change by learning about processes such as erosion and deposition.

We will end the topic by looking at how coastlines are being protected.

Music

Our theme this term is 'Film Music'. We will learn about how composers use music to help convey action and emotion in films before composing our own score for a film clip from Wallace and Gromit.

Art

Our focus in Art is 'Perspective' and we will use LS Lowry as our chosen artist to study. We will take inspiration from him to learn how line and shape can help us draw a realistic urban landscape.

PE

In PE, we will be using the 'personal cog' from Real PE, which will help us develop skills to challenge ourselves to be the best we can be, both in ball skills and in dance.

This term we are exploring positive ways to collaborate with others and the importance of compromising and negotiating during conflict.
