## **INSET Days**

We will be busy on Thursday and Friday with essential training and continuing professional development. The Learning Support team and Early Years teachers are renewing their first aid qualifications, and the rest of the teaching staff are going back to school to think about how to use assessment effectively in the classroom and how to ensure that the questions that we plan and use when teaching develop the children's learning. It is really important that as teachers, we continue to keep the training that we have current and that we maintain the view that reflective teaching is key, to ensuring that we improve and grow in our profession. I am always grateful that I have a team who are so willing to embrace training with enthusiasm and open-mindedness.

## **Office Cover after half-term**

As you will be aware for small schools such as ours budget are very tight. The majority of this pays for the teaching and support staff that run our classes and ensure our provision is exceptional for the children. At present Clare Yates efficiently organises much of the administrative and financial work across the two schools. The Governors and I are seeking to find the best solution to ensure that we have cover for the front desk and phones. After half-term you may see a new face answering the doors and telephones- my daughter Isabella Macey. She is doing this work in an unpaid and voluntary capacity. It would be really kind if you could make her welcome and please remember that she will not necessarily know the answers to questions, but can pass on the messages and ensure that you receive the answers.

## **Clubs after half-term**

We are grateful to our teachers and outside providers for offering the range of extra-curricular clubs for the children. We try to maximise the number of sessions by starting the provision promptly at the start of the school term. Please remind your children which clubs they are attending, and help your children to organise the equipment that they will need. We would also encourage them to keep to the commitment for the length of the half-term- a good practice for developing resilience and sticking power, which will be useful in the future.
