What your children will be learning this term

English

The term will start with us using the text 'King Kong' by Anthony Browne to explore viewpoint through writing a newspaper report. We will then be using a stimulus video depicting 'The Christmas Truce' from World War I to write a letter home to our loved ones.

Science

During this unit, children will continue to develop their understanding of evolution and how species have adapted to their environment over thousands of years. We will explore key concepts such as natural selection and inheritance, as well as learning about Charles Darwin and how he developed his theory of evolution whilst travelling the world.

Maths

Autumn 2 will begin with children converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers. We will then be consolidating our knowledge of different types of angles and identify unknown angles in shapes. At the end of term, we will use measurement as a context to help develop our understanding of numbers up to three decimal places.

History

Throughout this study, children will locate on maps where the Ancient Sumer were located developing understanding of this civilization. We will explore key Sumerian inventions, such as the wheel and ploughs, and how these have impacted later societies. We will then compare this civilization to others we have explored previously.

Music

This term we will learn about Blues music, naming key features of the genre. We will learn about chords and begin to play the 12-bar blues on tuned percussion.

Art/ DT

Children will plan and produce a pop up book, using a range of mechanisms and structures to make it interactive for a child in Beech class.

PE

In PE, we will be welcoming a member of Intergr8 dance to come and teach us Street Dance. We will also continue to have Harry from PBed, who will be doing gymnastics with us.
