What your children will be learning this term

English

In English our first writing journey will consist of looking at 'The Street Beneath My Feet' by Charlotte Guillain. Mixing urban and rural settings, covering subjects such as geology, archaeology and natural history, The Street Beneath My Feet offers children the opportunity to explore their world through a detailed learning experience.

We will then be studying a children's favourite of Harry Potter. The seven fantasy novels, by J.K. Rowling, chronicle the lives of a young wizard, Harry Potter, and his friends, Hermione Granger and Ron Weasley, all of whom are students at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry. They will be learning all about the Wizarding world and the magical characters within the story. They will be writing letters immersing themselves into this magical universe.

Maths

We will have opportunities to understand the following areas: Time, Multiplication, Division, Fractions, Number, Place Value, Addition and subtraction with statistics.

Science

The science topic for this term will be mixtures and separation. The children will learn how when some materials are mixed, it is possible to separate the mixture and get the original materials back again. They will see that there are several ways of separating mixtures of materials and the best process to use depends on the type you are separating. The children will be learning about evaporation, condensation, magnetism and filtering.

History/Geography

In Geography this term we will be comparing Stockbridge and Rio de Janeiro (South America).

This will be a comparative study to see what we can find that is similar or different in the landscape and geographical elements of both places.

Music

The children will have opportunity to:

- listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions and actions.
- build confidence among their peers through speaking opportunities such as talking about their likes and dislikes.

They will be learning about traditional instruments and improvisation with an Indian theme.

Art/DT

For Spring 2, we will be doing Forest school on Wednesdays which aligns with our DT project of structure building.

PE

In PE this term, Tuesday PE will be delivered by Personal Best Education. Wednesday PE will be delivered by Mr Harris.
