What your children will be learning this term

English

We will begin the term using the text 'The Unforgotten Coat' to write a guide to a Mongolian student about joining our school. We will then venture back into fiction writing, using the video 'The Alchemist's letter' to write a first-person narrative.

Science

In Science this term, children will develop their understanding of how light travels and how shadows are formed. We will investigate how light behaves when it hits different objects and how our eyes are designed to help us see.

Maths

This term will start with children looking at measures in different contexts. We will convert between different units of measure (including imperial and metric measures) and solve measure problems in different contexts. We will then explore the four operations with fractions.

History

Our history focus will be 'Early Islamic civilizations'. We will discuss how the civilization spread so quickly and compare the lives of rich civilians in Baghdad. We will finish the topic by evaluating the achievements of the civilization and its effect on the modern day.

Music

This term's unit focuses on teaching musical theatre, where children learn how singing, acting, and dancing combine to create an overall performance.

Art/ DT

Through our forest school time, children will learn skills to help them make playground structures.

PE

In PE, Harry will be focussing with the children on developing their stance and footwork. The children will also visit Farleigh school to develop their swimming skills.
