Homework for children in Year 2 at West Tytherley Primary School

Dear Parents/Carers,

Please see below the homework that you can expect your child to receive in Year 2.

Please note, this replaces the previous "Smiley Grid" incentive scheme.

Reading

It is very helpful for your child's progress if they read regularly with an adult at home.

Please try to complete **5** reads a week with your child - 3 of these with their colour banded book and 2 with a sharing book (a library or a reading corner book from school.)

As an incentive for your child, we will give a raffle ticket to them for completing this target.

If 5 reads are not possible, please aim for a minimum of **3** reads a week.

It is very important that you write in their reading record book so that the teachers can allocate rewards fairly.

Times Tables Rock Stars - important times tables practice

Please encourage your child to log on and play on the **studio**, **garage** or **gig** settings. These are the ones that ensure that your child will be practising the times tables which have been allocated by their class teacher. We would recommend playing for approximately 5 minutes per session and aiming for 3 sessions per week.

As an incentive for your child, we will give a raffle ticket to them for completing this target.

CGP Maths Weekly Work Out

The class teacher will allocate the pages that are to be completed for the week. It will be set on a Friday and should be returned by the following Thursday. This will then be marked and returned with the new pages allocated.

We will address any mistakes that are made which indicate that your child has not understood the task. This will be done in school. It is helpful if you are able to annotate the work with the level of support that your child needed.

The children will be given house points for completing this work

What is the purpose of the raffle tickets and house points as rewards for homework?

To encourage active and enthusiastic participation with the homework process, teachers will give your child house points to reward effort.

They will also receive a raffle ticket for completion of the TTRockstars and another for achieving 5 reads. This will go into a draw with other year 2 children, for an additional incentive such as: 10 minutes playtime with a friend, a hot chocolate with a teacher, a special pencil etc.
