As a school we have signed up to a competition to create a poster that emphasises the importance of using the Green Cross Code. We consider this to be particularly important in our setting, where children need to do this safely both during the day and at the start and end of school time. When in school, we have very clear processes for road crossing, which we operate at all times and the children are never unsupervised. This is not the case at the end of the day, so we need to make sure that the children are aware of the differences and are extra vigilant when crossing on their own. Please can we ask that parents keep a close eye on safe road crossing, when the children leave at the end of the day.
