

Computing

Children will explain which the home row keys are and how to find them when typing. They will learn how to use the spacebar and backspace correctly, type and make simple alterations to text using buttons on a word processor, search for, import and alter appropriate images for a text document, modify text in a document, use copy and paste to copy text from one document to another and explain what information is safe to be shared online.

RE

In Religious Education, we will investigate the concept of "Belonging", particularly within Judaism. Through a structured series of steps, students will reflect on their own responses to belonging and understand its significance within the Jewish faith, culminating in discussions about the importance of belonging to Jewish individuals and communities.

What your children will be learning this term

Maths

In Maths, we'll tackle geometry and measurement alongside addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, and number and place value. There will be plenty of engaging physical learning opportunities, and we'll spice things up with verbal reasoning questions and examples from everyday life to make it all relatable.

Science

Our Science topic will be all about animal survival! We will have fun identifying and naming various common animals like fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals. Children will sort animals into carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores, as well as describe and compare their structures. Plus, they'll identify and label the basic parts of the human body and learn about the senses associated with each part.

English

English will focus on "*Oliver's Vegetables*" by Vivian French. This delightful story will spark some exciting activities where children will learn to use noun phrases and sequence sentences to create short narratives. We'll also play around with the "-est" suffix and spice things up with adjectives to describe our favourite characters and scenes. We will then use "*The Night Gardener*" by the Fan Brothers and focus on writing vivid descriptive narratives. Along the way, they'll master using commas between adjectives, understand subordination, and get the hang of apostrophes for singular possession.

History

In History, we'll take a closer look at our very own West Tytherley. We'll explore the fascinating history of our village and the surrounding areas—there's so much to discover! We have a rich history in our own school that we can explore, before looking at the rest of the surrounding area.

Music

Children will explore keeping the pulse together through music and movement, by exploring their favourite things.

Art/DT

Chestnut class will discuss and see the artwork of Eddie Martinez, discuss and review the process of his work, drawing, painting and sculpture, compare and contrast to the work of Phyllida Barlow and create a final project.

PE

Children will develop and apply their sending and receiving and reaction and response through focused skill development sessions, thematic stories and games.
