What your children will be learning this term

English

Both learning journeys will be linked to our Science learning on space. We will begin by writing explanation texts using the book 'Curiosity' about the Mars Rover. We will then write instructions, using 'George's Secret Key to the Universe' as our stimulus.

Science

In Science this term, children will learn about the Earth's movement in space, the solar system, and gravity's role in keeping planets in orbit. Students will explore the Earth's rotation, day and night, seasons, and the concept of forces affecting objects' motion and weight.

Maths

This term will consolidate our understanding of fractions, manipulating denominators to compare, order and solve problems. We will also identify prime, square and cube numbers and solve problems using this knowledge.

Geography

This module explores the intricate interconnections of our planet. It includes a comparative study of contemporary geographical issues, emphasising the role of geographers in Europe, environmental geography in North America, contrasting landscapes in Asia and Antarctica, global trade relations in South America and Oceania, and natural resources in Africa.

Music

This term's unit focuses on a piece of music called "Fingal's Cave" by Mendelssohn (1830), which is a classical piece depicting the sea and waves swirling around Fingal's cave.

PE

In PE, children will be doing a dance unit with Miss Lee. They will develop shapes and create sequences of movement through partner work.

PSHE (Scarf)

Children will explore the topic 'Keeping safe' thinking about our emotional and physical needs, how to stay safe online and the difference between legal and illegal drugs.
