What your children will be learning this term

Literacy

To continue to learn phase 4 words:

- CVCVC (consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant), CCVC and CCVCC words.
- Tricky words: said, so, have, like, some, come, love, do, were, here, little, says, there, when, what, one, out, today.

To continue to have stories read to them and explore meaning and characters within those stories. To start to write their own stories and statements of facts using their known phonic sounds.

Expressive Arts and Design

To experiment with printmaking. They will be expressing themselves using different techniques. They will continue to play and compose music.

Mathematics

To continue to develop their counting skills, working on numbers to 20 and beyond.

To compare and explore the composition of numbers up to 10 including looking for odd, even and double numbers.

To investigate sharing and grouping different amounts.

Reading

To continue to develop their blending skills working on longer words.

They will continue to read in school 3 times a week.

RE

To consider the question:

“Why is the word ‘God’ so important to Christians?”

Communication and Language

To ask a range of questions to find out information. To take part in discussions and share their thoughts and ideas about various topics including locations around the world, climate and space.

Understanding the World

To continue to develop their understanding of the world through observing the changing season. They will be learning about the climate and seasons in different locations around the world as well as the people and culture.
