What your children will be learning this term

English

Using the text 'The Barnabus Project' as inspiration, Willow children will design their own 'failed experiment' and use organizational devices to make a fact file about them.

In Guided Reading, we will be exploring the text 'The BFG' by Roald Dahl.

Science

In Science this term, children will learn about electricity. We will identify if items are battery or mains powered before recognising the key components of a circuit. We will then problem solve and evaluate if circuits will work and if we can fix them.

Maths

This term focusses on developing our understanding of place value and introducing hundreds numbers. We will represent numbers in different ways, estimate their position on a number line and start to round numbers to the nearest 10 and 100.

History

We begin the year by looking at the impact the Roman Empire had on Britain. The children will learn about what life was like in Roman Britain and evaluate what the Romans left behind and what impact this has had on modern society.

Music

We will be exploring the music of jazz, learning about syncopated rhythms and practising call and response.

Art/ DT

Our art topic this term is called 'Crazy for clay'. We will take inspiration from Picasso's fish shaped jug and make our own 3D jug in the shape of an animal.

PE

In dance with Miss Lee, children will learn and develop shapes and circles to create sequences of movement.

PSHE (Scarf)

Children will explore the topic 'Being our best' and revise the importance of healthy eating and keeping our body fit. We will also identify our own achievements and what we can do well.
