




Inter-house Cross Country

Rockbourne Roman Villa - Willow Class Trip

On Wednesday, Willow Class had the pleasure of visiting Rockbourne Roman Villa in Fordingbridge, as part of their History topic. The children were taken on a tour of the site by volunteer John, who was extremely knowledgeable. We were able to see evidence of underfloor heating, the baths and even a beautiful mosaic believed to be the centre piece of the house. In the museum, there were plenty of artefacts on show that helped us picture what life would have been like on the farm all those years ago. We even got a chance to make our very own Roman mosaics! The day was finished with a surprise - volunteer John transformed into a Roman soldier and shared some of Rome's legacies with us, such as coins and a measurement system.


We are proud to celebrate the achievements of the following children:


