

Computing

In Computing, we will be using the use of 'big data' including barcodes, QR codes, infrared and RFID technologies.

French

In French, children will have the topic 'Sports and Clothes'. They will explore language related to this topic and how to use it in everyday life.

RE

In Religious Education, children will explore the concept of wisdom. They will discuss personal interpretations, analyse representations in the Qur'an and the Bible, and reflect on wisdom's significance for Muslims and Christians, as well as its impact on their lives and communities.

What your children will be learning this term

Maths

In Maths, we will cover fractions, geometry, addition and subtraction, algebra, and statistics. Children will engage in practical activities to understand fractions, explore geometric shapes, and enhance computational skills. Algebraic concepts will be introduced for solving simple equations, and statistics will involve data collection and interpretation.

Science

In Science, children will investigate how sounds are made, focusing on the relationship between vibrations and sound production. They will learn how vibrations travel through media to the ear and identify patterns linking pitch to sound-producing objects. Additionally, children will explore the correlation between sound volume and vibration strength, as well as sound intensity diminishing with distance.

English

In English, children will explore Fantastic Beasts by J.K. Rowling, focusing on a non-chronological report and a persuasive letter. The report will require research on magical creatures, while the letter will encourage children to persuade an audience about their protection. Additionally, children will create a monologue based on a short film and write a reflective diary entry using narrative language.

History

This History topic will examine the Mayan civilisation, focusing on their cities, culture, and diet. Children will compare the Mayan way of life with other civilisations to understand historical similarities and differences.

Music

In Music, we will use the concept of the Holi Festival to understand how colour can represent music. We will then perform a piece of music as a group.

Art/DT

In Art, we will focus on Beatriz Milhazes, a prominent South American artist. Children will engage in various artistic practices, including drawing, painting, sculpting, collage, and printing, inspired by Milhazes' vibrant style and cultural influences.

PE

In PE, we will have Intergr8 dance teaching Street Dance.

PSHE (Scarf)

In PSHE, children will look at the topic 'Rights Respecting'.
