What your children will be learning this term

English

This term, we will be doing an author study and exploring the books of Angela McAllister. We will begin with a recount letter based on the book 'Winter's Child' before using 'Leon and the Place Between' to write our own narrative.

Science

Children will learn that magnets attract or repel each other, will recognise magnetic and non-magnetic materials, and will explore how magnetic forces act at a distance. They will investigate poles, test everyday objects, and develop prediction and observation skills through hands-on enquiry and simple experimentation.

Maths

This term focusses on developing of measurement and using place value knowledge to help measure and compare length and mass. We will also explore time, including reading analogue and digital clocks.

Geography

We will be comparing our local area to the European city of Costa Brava in Spain, building our knowledge of their physical and human features and their climate. We will use information from atlases, graphs, tables and pictures to help us evaluate their similarities and differences.

Music

We will be learning about the main features of samba music, whilst singing and playing syncopated rhythms.

PE

We have the privilege of inviting Interg8 dance back to teach Street Dance. Harry will use Real PE to focus on cooperation and listening when jumping and landing.

PSHE (Scarf)

Children learn about 'Rights and Respect', thinking about how we can help ourselves and others. We will also develop our financial literacy by learning about budgeting.
