

Computing

In Computing, children will evaluate code, understand what it does and adapt existing code for a specific purpose.

French

In French, children will write using a text as a template and use a dictionary to research new vocabulary.

RE

The RE section will cover the timeline of the Bible's 'big story', explaining the ideas of Incarnation and Salvation. Children will look at the meaning of Jesus' death as a sacrifice and discuss different views on his death and resurrection. They will also connect the Christian belief in Jesus' sacrifice to the celebration of Holy Communion, showing how these beliefs are practiced. Finally, children will think about what sacrifice means in their own lives and its relevance in today's world.

What your children will be learning this term

Maths

In Maths, the lessons will cover a range of topics including multiplication, division, subtraction, addition, place value, and money. This well-rounded approach aims to strengthen children's basic skills while helping them use maths in real-life situations. Children will also develop problem-solving and reasoning skills through hands-on activities, practical examples, and guided practice.

Science

In Science, we will continue exploring sound, with children doing different investigations to learn how sound travels and how it affects volume and pitch. This will include experiments that test sound over distances, allowing children to engage in hands-on learning and develop their scientific skills.

English

In English, children will read the book *Rooftoppers*, which will help them write a persuasive letter and a diary entry. They will also explore poetry inspired by Joseph Coelho. After that, they will dive into *The Lizzie and Belle Mysteries: Drama and Danger* and write a biography. Throughout this, we will focus on using conjunctions and parentheses, as well as giving formal advice to improve their biographies.

Geography

In Geography, the goal is to boost children's understanding of economic activity, especially related to chocolate. They will look into how the UK is linked to the Ivory Coast through trade, gaining insights into global economic systems and their effects.

Music

In Music, children will perform a looped body percussion rhythm; keeping in time with their group and perform a piece with some structure and two different loops.

Art/DT

In Design and Technology, children will select three recipes to form a meal. They will follow and write a recipe to explore the process.

PE

In PE, children will explore the concept of 'Health and Fitness'.

PSHE (Scarf)

In PSHE, children will explore their friendships and different ways to navigate social situations.
