

Computing: Digital imagery

Children will create a pictorial story using photos. They will learn to take and edit images, organise them on a page, search for images safely, and understand what to do if something online makes them uncomfortable.

Geography: All beaches are the same - True or False?

Children will identify and describe the location of beaches, explore human and physical features, compare environments, and consider weather patterns to understand similarities and differences between coastal areas.

PE: Dance

In this unit, the children will learn and develop shapes and circles and create sequences of movement with these through partnering and artistry.

What your children will be learning this term

Maths

Year 1 children will compare mass, use accurate vocabulary, count in multiples, and solve addition and subtraction problems to 20. They will explore basic multiplication, division, and describe shapes, position, and movement.

Year 2 children will explore positional and directional geometry, revisit length, mass, capacity, and temperature, and consolidate addition, subtraction, place value, and fractions as equal parts to solve problems.

RE: Special Places

Children will explore the concept of special places by learning about Hindu Mandirs. They will describe what makes a place special, understand why Mandirs are important to Hindus, and relate these ideas to their own experiences.

English

Children will use text drivers to inspire writing for different purposes, including poetry. They will practise extending sentences with subordination and co-ordination, use noun and expanded noun phrases to describe, and build positive writing habits and stamina. We will be using the texts *The Lion and the Mouse* by Jerry Pinkney, *The Story Machine* by Tom McLaughlin and *If All the World Were* by Joseph Coelho

Science: How do plants grow?

Children will learn that plants grow from seeds and bulbs, which contain tiny plants and store food. They will explore how seeds germinate with water, and how plants need light, water, and protection to survive. They will also identify basic plant parts and understand how roots and shoots support growth.

Music: Under the Sea

In this unit, the children combine all the musical concepts learned throughout the year for an underwater-themed performance incorporating instrumental, vocal and body sounds.

Art/DT: Nature and Textiles

Children will study the work of Nancy Wolff and explore nature-inspired textiles. They will experiment with materials and techniques to create their own artwork, developing skills in texture, pattern, and creative design.

PSHE (SCARF): Keeping Safe

Children will learn about keeping safe and healthy, including the importance of sleep and positive bedtime routines. They will explore feelings of safety, trusted adults, and the PANTS rules, including privacy.
