

## Computing

Stop motion!

The aims are to understand that an animation is made up of a sequence of photographs. To know that small changes in frames will create a smoother looking animation. To understand what software creates simple animations and some of its features.

## Science

We will continue to learn about plants and learn that all flowering plants make seeds (reproduction) that can grow (germinate) into new plants. There are two main groups of seed plants – plants with cones and plants with flowers. Some plants die after it has produced its seed (annual) and sometimes the plant lives for many generations producing seeds each year (perennial).

## West Tytherley bitesize

What your children will be learning this term

### Maths

#### Year 1

Year 1 children will consolidate previously taught skills, including multiplication, division and fractions. They will learn about standard measures, telling the time, and sequencing events. They will also explore 2D and 3D shapes, using mathematical language to describe movement, position and direction.

#### Year 2

Year 2 children will revisit and secure their understanding of fractions, including recognising equal parts of a whole and solving a range of problems. They will also develop their knowledge of measure, telling the time to 5 minutes, and using precise mathematical language to describe shape, position and direction.

### PSHE (Scarf)

Children will be learning about growing and changing. Each year group has its own objectives which will go out in a separate communication.

### English

We will be exploring three key texts. First, 'A Walk in London' will inspire us to write a guidebook for a walking tour of London. Next, we will read 'A First Book of the Sea' to stimulate our imaginations and help us write poetry. Finally, we will read 'Lost and Found' and use it as inspiration to write our own stories.

Year 1 children will focus on writing simple sentences and building them into short narratives, using conjunctions to join clauses and concentrating on correct letter formation. Year 2 children will develop their use of adverbs, select appropriate vocabulary, use punctuation and conjunctions accurately, and improve their spelling.

### History

We will be learning about queens and their significance in the past. The children will travel back 500, 200, and 70 years to explore the lives, achievements and reigns of different queens. We will compare these historical figures to understand how their roles and influence have changed.

### Music

This half term the children learn folk songs and create sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.

### Art/DT

We will be investigating strong shapes and the properties of stiff and flexible materials by designing a chair inspired by the story 'There's a Bear on My Chair'.

### RE

In RE we are learning about the creation story discussing that the Earth and everything in it are important to God. God has a unique relationship with human beings as their Creator and Sustainer. Humans should care for the world because it belongs to God.
