What your children will be learning this term

Maths

In Mathematics, children will focus on ratios and proportion, fractions and geometry, alongside extended use of the four operations in a range of different contexts. Learning will support children to apply known strategies accurately, reason about relationships between numbers and shapes, and solve problems with increasing independence.

Science

In Science, children will continue their work on controlling circuits. They will look closely at how circuits function and investigate ways in which they can be controlled. Through exploring, experimenting and testing different circuit configurations, children will develop their understanding of electrical components and the role they play in creating and controlling a complete circuit.

English

In English, children will begin with *The Errand*, using the text to develop skills in following directions and writing a narrative that creates atmosphere. They will consider how language choices influence the reader and how effective description can be used to build mood and setting. Later in the unit, children will study *Night Mail* to explore poetry in more depth, focusing on how modal verbs and adverbs can be used to shape meaning and style. This work will support children in developing confidence in both reading and writing.

Geography

In Geography, children will study biomes and climate zones. They will improve their knowledge and understanding of four biomes, enabling them to identify, describe, compare and evaluate them.

Music

In Music, children will learn to sing and follow melodies within the context of the school play: *Alice in Wonderland*.

Art/DT

In DT, children will make a steady hand game and create a success criteria. They will design and use a functioning circuit to work in their product.

PE

In PE, children will continue with their sending and receiving skills outside. Children will also be extending their gym skills within lessons.

PSHE (Scarf)

In PSHE, children will learn within their year groups to the 'Growing and Changing' unit.
