What your children will be learning this term

English

This term, we will use 'Charlotte's Web' as a stimulus to write a persuasive letter. We will also write our own piece of poetry in the style of 'The Night Box'.

Science

We will continue learning about plants this term and explore how plants reproduce. We will identify key parts of a flower and use investigations to evaluate the shape of different seeds based on how far they can travel. We will also explore different types of seed dispersal.

Maths

We will begin this term's consolidation of measurement by recalling key facts of time and reading analogue clocks to the nearest minute. We will also be converting between different units of measure and using this to solve word problems in different contexts.

Geography

Throughout this unit, children will try to answer the question 'Is every country equal?'. They will identify different natural resources and where they are located around the world before deciding if these resources are distributed fairly.

Music

Throughout this unit, children will explore the style of rock and roll music, trying to play a rock and roll bassline on glockenspiels and keyboards.

PE

Children will have the opportunity to develop a variety of personal skills in Forest School with Miss Lee and Mrs Archer. They will also continue to develop their sending and receiving skills with our PBED coaches.
