Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to a new school year! I hope you all had a delightful summer.

Our first day together will be Thursday 3rd September. I am thoroughly looking forward to greeting you all at the door at 8.45am, ready and raring to go! I look forward to working collaboratively with you this year to ensure your children have as much fun and make as much progress as possible.

Homework is an important aspect of our learning process, as it helps to reinforce the skills we develop in class and help prepare children for secondary school by practising time management and organisation outside of school hours. As your child is now in upper key stage two, we expect children to read at least five times a week. We strongly encourage children to read aloud, which fosters both confidence and comprehension skills. They may choose to read their own books on three occasions and share a book with an adult or sibling on two occasions. Additionally, there will be a homework allocation which includes completing the CGP books and contributing to Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) three times a week.
